

While at the Library of the University of Gdańsk, it is required to obey the following rules:

1. Using a face mask.
2. Keeping the minimal interpersonal distance of 1,5 m.
3. Not using the restricted seats or areas.
4. Using disinfectants available both at the entrance to the Library and on every floor in the free-access areas.
5. Leaving one's outer clothing in the self-service cabinets.
6. Not exceeding the maximal number of 110 persons in all three reading rooms of the Main Library at the same time.
7. Not exceeding the maximal number of persons in the Scientific Information Reading Room and the specialist libraries, which is:
 - a. 25 in the Scientific Information Reading Room,
 - b. 15 in the Economic Library,
 - c. 20 in the Law Library,
 - d. 10 in the Humanistic Library,
 - e. 19 in the Philology Library,
 - f. 8 in the History of Culture Library,
 - g. 4 in the Oceanographical Reading Room.

At the Main Library the body temperature is measured by means of a touch-free thermometer. The readers with a temperature above 37 centigrades or the readers who refuse to have their temperature measured will not be allowed to enter the Library.
